

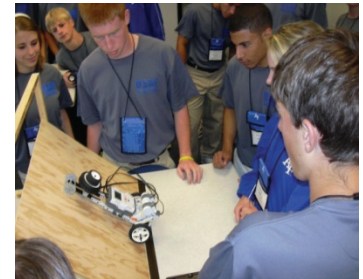


USAF Academy Summer Seminar
